CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

I, as a participant in studying Spanish at The Spanish Language Institute (ILE) Study Abroad program, agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct. I hereby affirm and agree that if I violate this Code Of Conduct, disciplinary measures may be taken against me. If I commit any violations that are deemed by ILE'S Consejo Directors to be a serious violation of this Conduct, I recognize and accept that I may be removed from the program. I would forfeit my right to a refund of any and all money paid.

- 1. I will respect the security guidelines of ILE. I will limit my movements to the ILE study and ministry locations, and approved housing areas. Any movement outside that area will be accompanied by at least one other participant and with the expressed permission of and knowledge of ILE'S Campus Pastor and/or Academic Director.
- 2. I will abstain from drinking any alcoholic beverages as a participant in the Study abroad program. I understand that this is a global guideline for ILE and their participating university members.
- **3.** I will not produce, use, distribute, sell or keep in my possession any illegal drugs.
- **4.** I will not spend the night or reside in any location other than the approved housing to which I am assigned, unless by the expressed permission of ILE's Campus Pastor and/or Academic Director.
- **5.** I will not leave the city of the ILE program, during the duration of the program or schedule any international trips for any reason without the expressed permission of the Campus Pastor and/or Academic Director.
- 6. I will be prompt and attend all classes and scheduled meetings as required.
- **7.** I will carry out to the best of my abilities, all academic assignments given to me.
- **8.** I will abide by all the directives and instructions given to me by authorized program staff and representatives of ILE.



- **9.** I will not lie, cheat, steal and will conduct myself with the utmost integrity and ethical behavior while participating in this program.
- **10.** I will do my best to get along with other participants and maintain a spirit of open-mindedness to their opinions as well as a spirit of forgiveness for perceived wrongs.
- 11. I will express any grievances about the summer program or participating personnel to ILE's Campus Pastor.
- **12.** I will respect local customs and traditions, and not engage in any activities that bring disgrace or disrepute upon ILE, its program partners or representatives or the Lord.
- 13. Reflecting Christ also means displaying God's distinctive character in grateful response to Christ's costly redemption (1 Peter 1:15–19). Holiness entails separation from the godless "world" system (1 John 2:15–17; Ezra 6:21) by discerning where one's culture reflects evil values. By living holy, separated lives, we publicly proclaim that only He is worth loving and following. One of the primary ways we pursue holiness is through moral purity. In calling us to purity, God forbids viewing sexuality as a means of exploiting others (1 Thess. 4:1–8). This means honoring God's design for sex, celebrating and practicing it only within the marriage relationship between one man and one woman for a lifetime. Since what we do springs from how we think (Mark 7:20–23), this commitment also means controlling what one allows him or herself to view and read (Matt. 5:27–30) and petitioning God's Spirit to purify one's thoughts, motives and actions.
